

Article 71

(Employment without a work permit of international scientific missions - PB/6-6)

(1) Members of international scientific missions referred to in Article 84, paragraph (1), item f) of the Law, in addition to the application for the approval or extension of temporary residence permit, and apart from the evidence of meeting the general requirements for the approval of temporary residence referred to in Article 53 of the Law and 58 of this Bylaw, shall submit:

- a) evidence that the alien is a member of an international scientific mission which conducts research in Bosnia and Herzegovina approved by the Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina with the evidence of the engagement of an alien and the time period of the engagement,
- b) evidence that the research in Bosnia and Herzegovina was approved by the Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina,
- c) a certificate from a competent body in Bosnia and Herzegovina which engages the alien, which obliges it to defray the costs of accommodation, medical costs, ensure the support and defray all the other costs which may incur as a result of the alien's stay in Bosnia and Herzegovina, as well as the cost of placing under supervision, voluntary leave of the country or forced removal, and all other costs that result from an alien leaving Bosnia and Herzegovina.
