## Article 87 (Treatment or rehabilitation - PB/7)

- (1) Temporary residence permit may be granted to an alien for the purpose of his/her medical treatment in health institutions, therapy communes or communities, spa facilities and similar, which are registered in Bosnia and Herzegovina for the performance of such activities.
- (2) In addition to the application for the approval or extension of temporary residence permit, and apart from the evidence of meeting the general requirements for the approval of temporary residence referred to in Article 53 of the Law and 58 of this Bylaw, an alien shall submit:
  - a) evidence form the health institution, therapy commune or community, that is, a spa facility or similar in Bosnia and Herzegovina that the alien will be ensured treatment or rehabilitation, with a note on the time period of the treatment or rehabilitation,
  - b) evidence on advance payment made of at least 50% of the costs of treatment or rehabilitation.
- (3) Temporary residence is granted for the duration of the medical treatment or rehabilitation, for the maximum of up to one year, provided that the validity of the alien's passport exceeds the period of temporary stay by three months.
