

Article 25
(Reasons for entry refusal)

- (1) An alien shall be refused to enter BiH if he/she fails to meet the entry requirements referred to in Article 19 (*General entry conditions*) nor shall they be subject to application of the international treaty or decision referred to in Article 20 (*Entry on special conditions*) of this Law.
- (2) An alien may be refused to enter BiH apart from the reasons referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article if:
- a) while attempting to enter BiH he/she submits a falsified travel document;
 - b) while attempting to enter BiH he/she submits a falsified visa or permit for temporary residence;
 - c) he/she already spent 90 days on BiH territory in the period of 6 months, counting from the day of the first entry, and if he/she is a citizen of no-visa regime country, unless he/she is subject to the provision referred to in Article 20 of this Law;
 - d) there are grounds for suspicion that he/she will conduct a type of business for which a work permit is necessary, and to whom the provisions of Article 84 of this Law are not applied.
